

In an effort to keep everyone upto-date regarding our new building, the following information is provided.

We have received the \$6,000 check from the good brethren at North Jackson in Jackson, TN. This money was given through the efforts of Steve Hopper. It gave us JUST enough to have what we need for the down-payment on the building.

We plan to close in just a few days, on-or-before August 25. We have informed the landlord of the facilities we now rent that we will be moving out at the end of this month. This all means that we plan to meet in the new facilities Sunday, September 7.

A check for \$1,000 was also received from the Maryville congregation last week. This is the beginning of the \$25,000 or so we will need to get the NEW building furnished and read to use.

The Nashville Road congregation, to which we owe so much, is also helping us by reducing our payment to them from \$1,000 per month to \$500 a month for the next year. For those who may not know, this good church loaned us the money to buy the land on Boyd's Creek Road, and we have been paying it back at \$1,000 per month.

All of this means one thing: it is going to be extremely busy around here for the next little while. After our Men's Meeting this afternoon, we will know more about a time table. But, we will certainly need people to help get the new building ready for occupancy and to help us move there.
