RECALCULATING

If you have some kind of GPS system in your car, you know it is not uncommon to hear the voice say, “**Recalculating.**” It is our desire to keep everyone completely informed regarding our efforts to purchase a new church building, the money raised and the money still needed.

Therefore, here are some of our recalculations.

First, we have decided to take the loan Smart Bank offered. It suited our needs better than the one from Y12 Credit Union. The interest rate was 1/4 percent better. The origination fee was 1/2 percent less, and the closing costs were \$3,000-\$4,000 less. Plus, with some encouragement from Tommy Lambert, they also agreed to give a 25-year loan. Another major plus was that they required 20% down, instead of the 25% from Y12.

This means our down payment, plus the closing costs will be \$114,000. Of that amount, we have saved and raised \$106,945 to date. This means we still need \$7,055.

In addition to this amount, we will need at least \$25,000 to put in a baptistery, purchase furnishing, and made some minor revisions to the building.

Our best calculation is that the monthly payment on the loan will be \$2,443, which is only \$243 more than we are currently paying for rent. To help us initially, we will pay only the interest for the first year.

We have come a long way, but we have some distance to go yet. Working together, and with God’s continued blessings, we will be able to raise the additional money needed.
