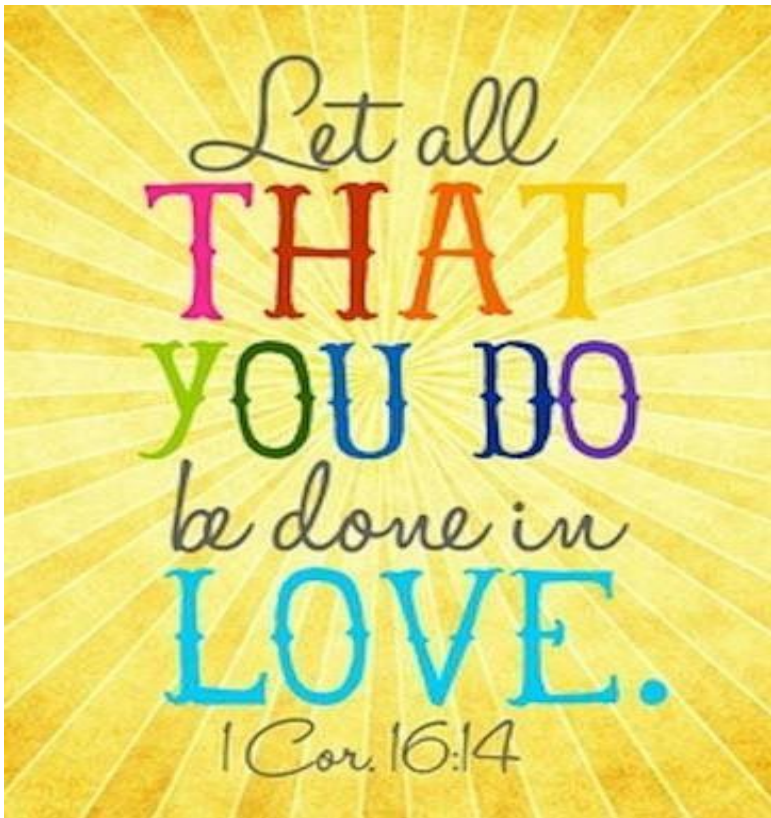

THINGS TO BRING TO CHURCH WITH YOU

BRING A SMILE. *“I was glad when they said to me, ‘Let us go into the house of the Lord’”* (Psa. 122:1). If you are glad to be here, let your face show it. Smile! Greet others warmly.

BRING A HUMBLE HEART. *“You are worthy, O Lord, for You have created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created”* (Rev. 4:11). Worship is bowing before God to honor and praise Him. There is no room for pride or arrogance. Worship is about God; not about us. It is the opportunity to stand in His majestic presence.

BRING YOUR BIBLE. *“All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly furnished for every good work”* (2 Tim. 3:16-017). We will read, study, discuss, and learn from the Bible. Bring yours with you. You might even want to bring a notepad and pen.

BRING AN OPEN MIND. *“‘Come now, and let us reason together,’ says the Lord”* (Isa. 1:18). We should all be honest searchers after truth. Everyone has opinions, but all opinions must be measured by the Word. With Jesus, we should say, “not My will but Yours be done” (Luke 22:42).

BRING A FRIEND. As soon as Andrew encounter Jesus, he said to his brother, Peter, *“We have found the Messiah”* (John 1:41). Don't keep good things to yourself. Share what you have found. Invite a neighbor, a co-worker, a friend, or a relative to come with you.
