

With other money already received, this means that we now have \$8,300 in our building fund. That day’s contribution will go toward the funds needed to get the new building ready for occupancy. We are not there yet, but we are gaining on it. . . . **More good news:** an email from the Chase Park congregation in Huntsville, where Jeff Husband is a deacon, is sending a check for \$1,000, and they are also donating some chairs to us. That will make our total in hand \$9,300.
