

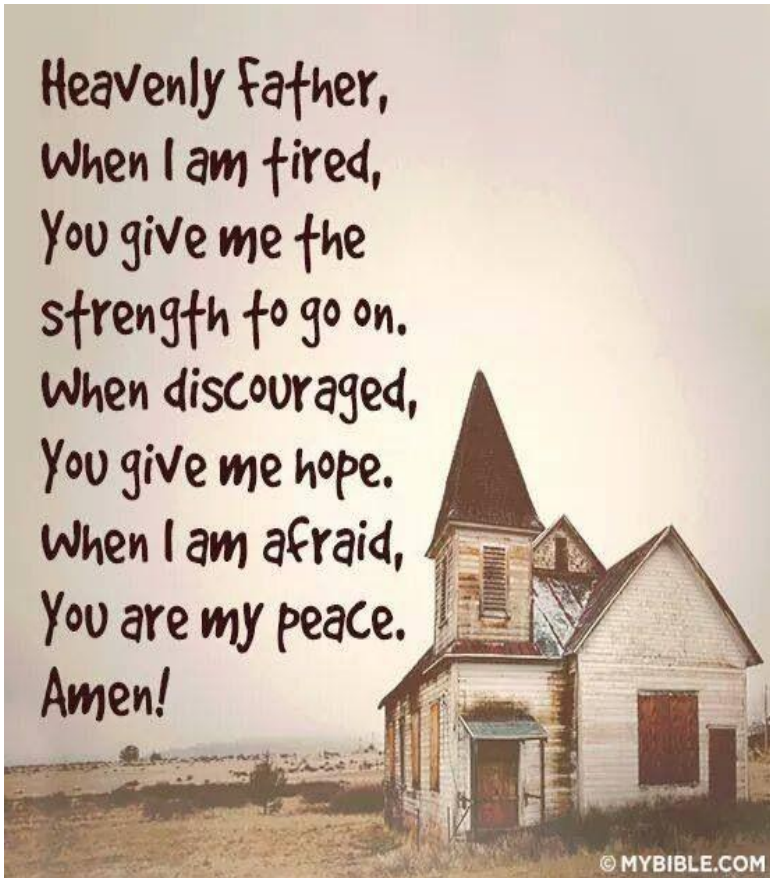

FACTS & FIGURES

As we go forward with our goal of purchasing a new, permanent church building, we want to make sure that everyone is kept informed. To that end, printed below is the information as it stands at this time.

- ✓ The price of the new building, plus an additional lot for parking, is \$535,000.
- ✓ At the last appraisal, this property appraised for \$630,000.
- ✓ The loan we have applied for is 75% of the purchase price, or \$401,250.
- ✓ The monthly payment on this amount is approximately what we are presently paying in rent, \$2,200.00.
- ✓ The down payment we must have is 25% of the loan purchase price, or \$133,750.
- ✓ We currently have \$65,422 in the “Building Fund,” which does not count the \$3,000 we have already given as earnest money.
- ✓ The closing costs are estimated to be about \$10,000.
- ✓ This means we have \$75,328 left to raise.
- ✓ It is estimated that it will also take \$20-25,000 additional dollars to get the building ready. This would include furnishings, a baptistery, and some renovations.
- ✓ The closing date has been set for August 31.
- ✓ A special contribution is planned for next Sunday (but not limited to that day) to see what our own members are willing and able to give to help with the down payment.
- ✓ The lot on Boyd’s Creek Road is being offered for sale
