## ANNOUNCEMENTS

**A**nnouncements have jokingly been referred to as “the sixth item of worship.” We know they are necessary to the life of the congregation, but different questions confront us. When do we make the announcements? Exactly what do we announce, i.e., what is appropriate to announce before the congregation? What method(s) do we use in getting the announcements out?

At Seymour, we try hard to keep everyone informed regarding those things that go on in the congregation and in the lives of our members.

For instance, we publish our weekly bulletin, *Seymour Savings* and make it available to you each Sunday. Also, we verbally make announcements at the beginning and/or end of each service. Just recently, we purchased the equipment which allows us to scroll through the announcements using a projector and power point slides. Last month, we also began the publication of a monthly calendar, which will be a reminder of scheduled events.

Having said all of this, I am going to ask you to take some initiative and help us with the process. First, get any announcements to be included in the bulletin or on the power point slides to me in a timely manner. Be sure to give adequate information about the person, event, etc., so we can publish the announcements in an accurate and understandable way.

Second, be sure to read the bulletin carefully, watch the power point slides as they scroll through, and listen to the verbal announcements as they are made.
