TWO AREAS OF EMPHASIS

This year, we have a number of goals, but we have two primary areas of emphasis.

First, we are emphasizing **LEADERSHIP** this year. By the end of the year, we hope to be in a position to appoint elders and deacons to serve the congregation. We are taking slow, measured steps toward this goal. We want to make sure that everyone is well versed in what the men who serve in these ways are to do and what qualifications they must possess.

To help with the funds needed to begin a new curriculum, and to meet other classroom needs, the contribution today is earmarked for our Educational Program Fund.

In the long run, the new curriculum will be cheaper to use, because much of it will be reusable. At the beginning, however, it will require several hundred dollars for maps, time-lines, teachers' resources, etc.
