Mistakes! We all make them; don't we?

Some mistakes are rather minor. They allow us to laugh at ourselves and provide opportunities for a little good-natured ribbing. Other mistakes, however, are of greater consequence. Some of them even have eternal consequences. More clearly stated, these mistakes are sins.

Our mistakes can crush people's spirits, alienate those who have the closest of relationships to us, and even place our souls in jeopardy. No matter the mistake, we should respond appropriately. The steps are as easy as one, two, three.

One, we must admit the mistake. Instead of trying to blame someone else, or justify it in some way, we just simply say, "I did it."

Two, we must seek to make it right. Unfortunately, sometimes we don't get that opportunity. But, where we can, we must correct the mistake, make the apology, ask for forgiveness.

Three, we must resolve to do better. It is one thing to make a mistake, and it is another thing not to learn anything from it. Thankfully, as long as life continues, we have opportunity to do better.

These are the very things David did. You can read his own words in Psalm 51.
