RELATIONSHIPS

From the time we are born, we enter into relationships. As we go through life, we have relationships with parents, siblings, extended family members, friends, mates, co-workers, brothers and sisters in Christ, to name some.

Our relationships affect us greatly, either positively or negatively. They can enrich our lives or diminish them. It was the negative influence of relationships that caused Paul to write, “Do not be deceived: ‘Evil company corrupts good habits’” (1 Corinthians 15:33).

In the lesson this morning, I want to begin a three-part study of relationships. In these lessons, we will look at some of our most basic relationships as disciples of Jesus. The text for each one is a part of John 15, and there is a key word that describes the essence of each of the relationships.

Listed below are the titles, texts, and key words for each one.

- ✓ **“The Disciple’s Relationship with Jesus.”** The text is John 15:1-8 and the key word is “Abide.”
- ✓ **“The Disciple’s Relationship with Other Disciples.”** The text is John 15:9-17, and the key word is “Love.”
- ✓ **“The Disciple’s Relationship with the World.”** The text is John 15:18-25. and the key word is “Hate.”
