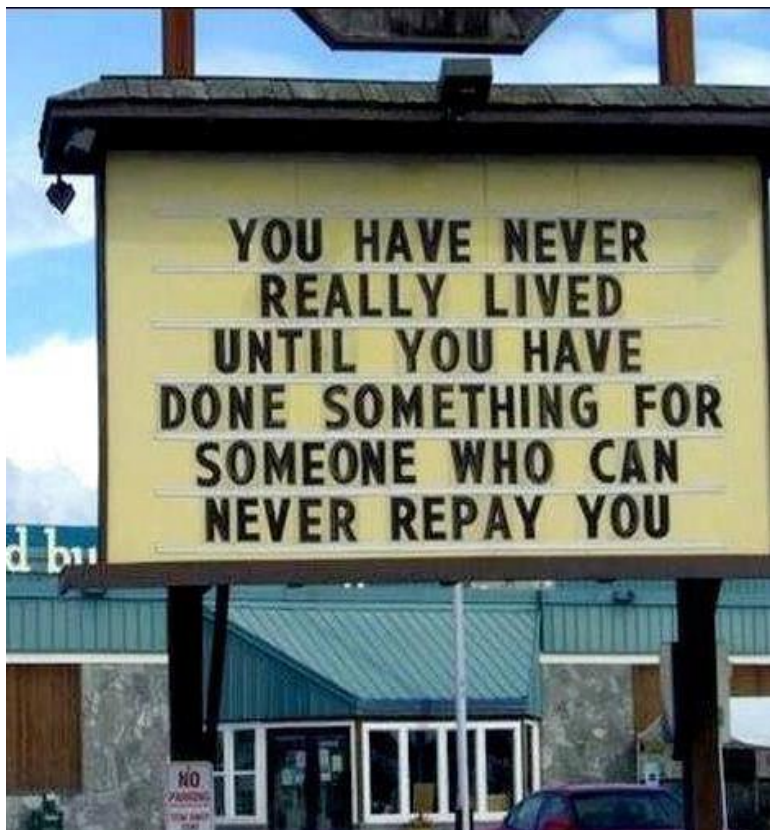

BE READY

Paul instructed Titus to remind the brethren in Crete **“to be ready for every good work”** (Titus 3:1). In fact, the key phrase in this little book is “good works” (1:16; 2:7,14; 3:1,8,14).

I want to remind us to do the same thing. We have two good opportunities before us to do that at this time.

First, we have been asked to be involved in collecting **“Treats for the Troops.”** Personal hygiene items, as well as other things, are being collected to be sent to our men and women who serve in our armed forces abroad.
