BUILDING DEDICATION

Next Sunday, October 12, is the date for the dedication of our new facilities. To dedicate is to “set apart for, or devote to, a special purpose.”

Solomon’s temple was dedicated with great pomp and circumstance (1 Kings 8). One of the annual feasts the Jews observed was the Feast of Dedication (John 10:22).

As a child, Jesus was brought to the temple and presented to God (Luke 2:22). In Romans 12:1, Paul calls upon Christians to “present your bodies as living sacrifices, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.” In both cases, the word “present” carries the idea of dedication.

So, dedication of someone or something to the glory and work of God is not anti-biblical. We want to make sure that our new facilities are presented to the Lord to be used for purposes that will honor Him and benefit all who enter its doors.
