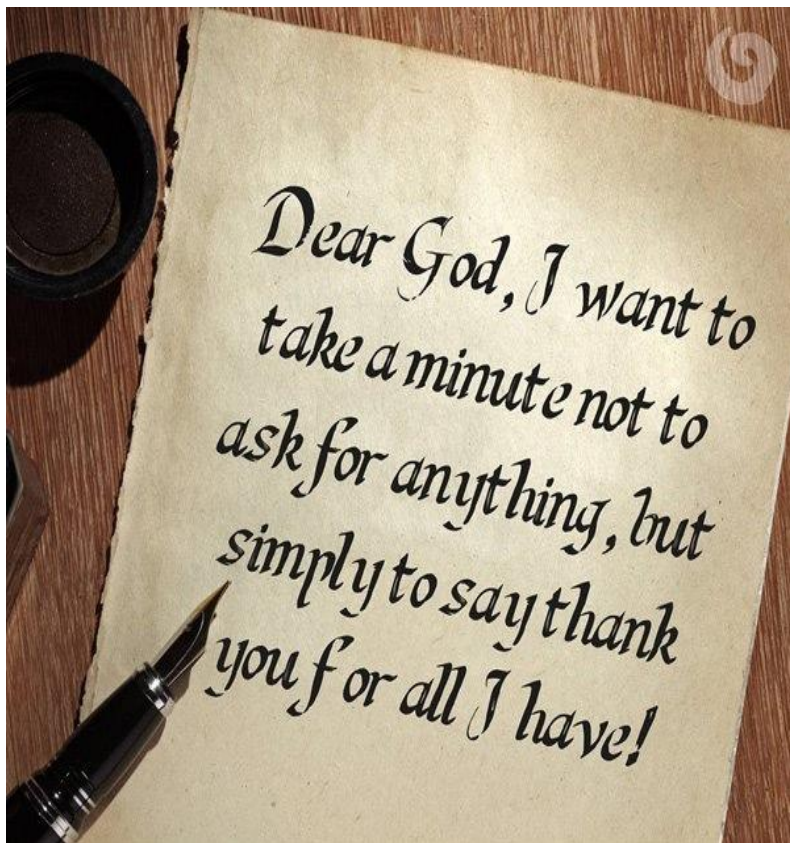

PHIL ADAMS CONSIDERED FOR DEACON

Phil Adams is being placed before the congregation today to be considered as an additional deacon. We are blessed to have Phil and Darlene with us, and our elders believe Phil would be an excellent addition to our deacons.

The elder's plan is for Phil to work in the area of congregational involvement. For a congregation to grow and prosper, it is important for every member to be actively involved. ***“But, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ—from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love”*** (Eph. 4:15-16).

If approved, Phil would be the deacon in charge of trying to make sure everyone is “plugged in” and that jobs get done. Our elders believe he is uniquely prepared through experience and training to function in this area.

The sermon this morning will be a review of the qualifications and work of deacons. We ask that you consider Phil in light of the things that will be discussed.

Our elders are giving two weeks for Phil to be considered. If you have any concerns, please discuss those matters with them during this period. If no scriptural objections are received and sustained, Phil will be installed as a deacon on Sunday morning, August 30.
