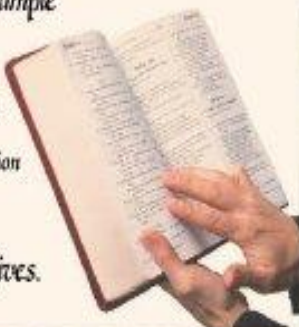

HELP OUR BIBLE SCHOOL PROGRAM

We had our 1st Annual Teacher's Appreciation Dinner last evening, and today we want to continue to emphasize our Bible School Program. Here are five pretty simple things we can all do to help.

ATTEND. Our teachers work hard to prepare each class session and to make it beneficial to each student. Their efforts, however, are only of benefit to those who attend. So, be there. If you have children, attend as a family.

PREPARE. We expect teachers to prepare. Shouldn't we expect students to prepare, too? Get a good night's rest. Get up early enough to be on time. If you know the subject matter or biblical passage to be studied, read over it in advance of the class. And, don't forget your Bible.

PARTICIPATE. Nothing makes a Bible study session any more interesting and beneficial than good comments and questions from those in attendance. Don't monopolize the class period, and don't ask impertinent questions, but take part.

INVITE. Invite others to come with you. We often invite people to the worship service, but why not to the Bible classes, also? It might surprise you who would accept your invitation.

VOLUNTEER. Not everyone can, or even should, be a teacher. I believe, however, that more people can teach than are. Sign up to be a helper, if you don't think you are ready to teach. We are always looking for additional teachers and helpers.
