



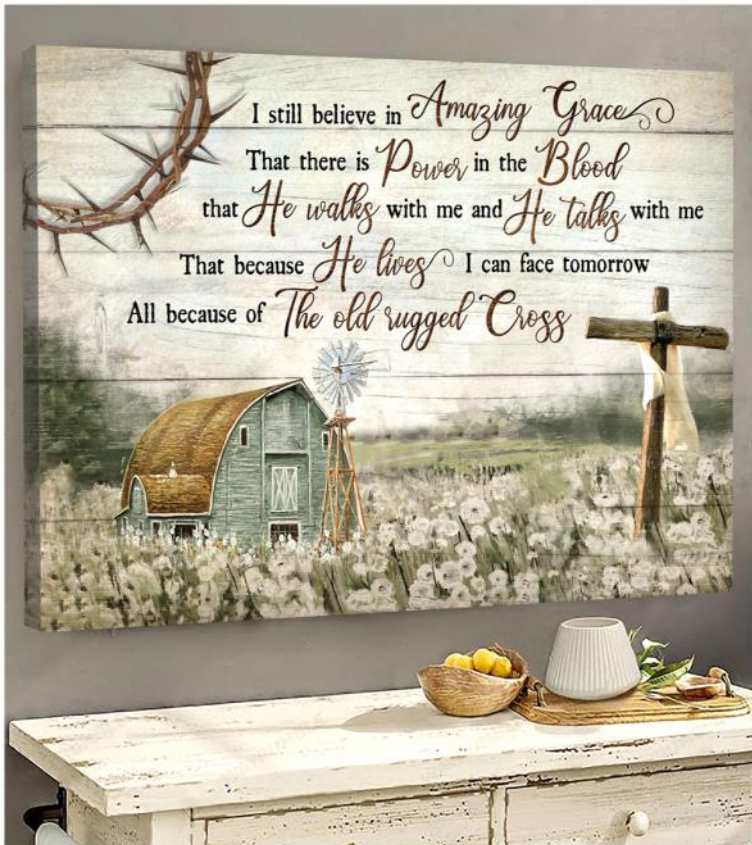

TEAMWORK

Back during “March Madness,” I was watching one of the many college basketball games being broadcasted. I remember one of the announcers saying, after an awkward, hurry up shot was taken and missed, “That was a ‘me’ shot and not a ‘we’ shot.”

I got the point. In that situation, the shooter seemed to be more intent on making a shot for his own glory and satisfaction than on passing to a teammate who would have a better opportunity to make the shot and score.

There are many ways to think about the local congregation. One of those ways is to think of it as a team. It is not about me. It is about us. We are to cooperate together for the good of the body and for the glory of Jesus Christ.

Paul understood this. As important as he was to the cause of Christ, he realized he was only one of many. He wrote, **“I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase. So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase”** (1 Cor. 3:6-7).

To the church at Ephesus, he wrote, **“from whom the whole body joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love”** (Eph. 4:16).

Go team. It is not me. It is us. It doesn’t matter who gets the credit.
