





CE CHRISTIANS

I read an article recently that talked about “CE Christians.” I used that reference in our BOOST podcast last Tuesday. A preacher friend in West Virginia responded that he had never heard of CE Christians.

Neither had I, until I read that article. The CE stand for Christmas and Easter. So, CE Christians are people who try to relegate their religion to a couple of “holy days” each year.

Someone, certainly with tongue in cheek, did suggest that we might put Easter eggs on the Christmas tree and cut it down to one day.

The birth of Christ and His resurrection from the dead are important events in human history. We need to remember the significance of both.

An important point to be made, however, is that we have neither a command nor an example in the New Testament to observe either of these in some special way on a specific day of the year.

As New Testament Christians, we assemble each Lord’s Day to surround the Lord’s Table to remember His death. We do have a command and an example in regard to that (Matt. 26:26-30; Acts 20:7; 1 Cor. 11:23-30).

As is often said, “The place for the Lord’s people on the Lord’s Day is in the Lord’s house around the Lord’s table.”
