HAVE YOU BEEN WITH JESUS?

In Acts 4, Peter and John found themselves in trouble with the Jewish religious leaders. Of what were they guilty? They preached the resurrection of Jesus to a crowd that had gathered following the healing of a crippled man.

They were brought before the Sanhedrin and asked by what power they had done, and where doing, the things they were. Rather than presenting a defense, Peter and John took the opportunity to fearlessly preach about Jesus of Nazareth. They concluded by affirming that Jesus was indeed alive and that there was no salvation to be found apart from Him.

Verse 13 record the reaction of the Jewish leaders. **“When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized they were unschooled, ordinary men, they were astonished and took note that these men had been with Jesus.”**

Through such things as the healing of the crippled man, their bold declaration regarding the resurrection of Jesus from the dead, and their deep convictions, it was quite evident that Peter and John had been with Jesus. There was no other explanation for what they were saying and doing.

As I read this story, I could not help but wonder if we are acting in such a way that people would conclude that we have met and are associated with Jesus. Does our faith, convictions, words, and deeds drive people around us to this conviction? Or, after meeting us and spending time with us, would they conclude that we don't even know Him?
