A FORMULA FOR SOUL WINNING

Psalm 126:5-6 is a wonderful, divine formula for soul winning. Consider it.

“Those who sow in tears. . .” We must agonize over those who are lost, and we must have a burning desire to see them saved. Paul expressed his agony for his brethren in the flesh with these words: “Brethren, my heart’s desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they might be saved” (Rom. 10:1).

“. . . shall reap in joy.” God has promised that His Word would not return void (Isa. 55:11). We may plant and water, but it is always God who gives the increase (1 Cor. 3:6).

“He who continually goes forth . . .” The “Great Commission” is all about going (Matt. 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16). We cannot save the world by sitting in our church buildings. We cannot rely alone on inviting people to our services. We must get to where people are and tell them about Jesus.

“Bearing seed for sowing.” The seed is the Word (Luke 8:11). The power is not in the messenger but in the message. It is alive and powerful (Heb. 4:12). We are mere clay pots containing a life-giving message (2 Cor. 4:7).

“Shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.” There is the promise again. God rewards the efforts of those who do His will.

What a task before us! What a promise to motivate us!
