THE IMPORTANT VERSUS THE MORE IMPORTANT

The services last Sunday morning ended on a meaningful and emotional note. Jeff, Lynn, and Natalie Whitaker all responded to the invitation asking the elders to lead the congregation in prayer for Jeff's impending open-heart surgery.

Thankfully, the surgery was successful last Tuesday, and Jeff has begun the long, painful recovery period. Please continue to pray for this good family.

At some point that evening, Lynn said, "We're not even thinking about Christmas this year. This is more important. We just want to get Jeff back to feeling well again."

That reminded me of an important principle. Some things are important, but they may be "trumped" by things that are more important. Here are some examples.

- ✓ It is important to be heard, but sometimes it is more important to just listen with an open mind (Jas. 1:19),
- ✓ It is important to receive with grace, but Jesus said it is more important to learn the joy of giving (Acts 20:35).
- ✓ It is important to attend Sunday evening and Wednesday evening services, but sometimes it is more important to perform acts of needed service for someone (Gal. 6:10).
- ✓ It is important to oppose error at any level, but it is always more important to be kind and forgiving when we approach people (Eph. 4:32; 2 Tim. 2:24).

Yes, some things are important, but there are often things more important. What else can you add to this short list?
