SOME INTERESTING STATISTICS

Rusty Curtis, who is our Webmaster, gave me some interesting statistics last week and suggested that I make them available.

Last year (2017) we had more than 35,000 hits on our website. This would mean that we had nearly 3,000 hits per month. Some 8,400 of these were to read the blog that we post there about once a month. 3,360 of them were to listen to the Sunday sermons. The rest were to read the bulletin, check the monthly men's schedule, or just to browse through the things that are offered there.

We began our weekly Boost Podcast toward the end of the year. In fact, we posted ten of them on Facebook in 2017. The numbers keep rising, but there were more than 18,000 views of those ten podcasts, which is an average of some 1,800 views per week.

What does all of this mean? It means that the internet is an effective way to get our message out to people, and that we should explore how we can use this method even more effectively than we already are.

I want to thank those of you who have helped us promote our posts by viewing them, liking them, sharing them, and commenting on them. This exponentially increases our audience. It makes you a real and important part of our outreach.
