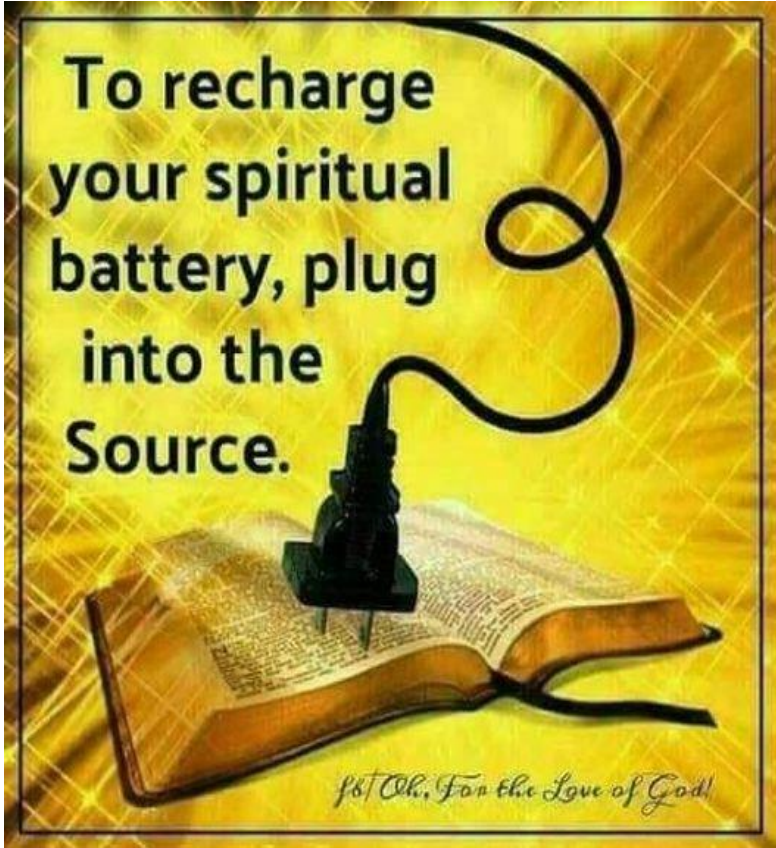

A PLACE OF PRAYER
