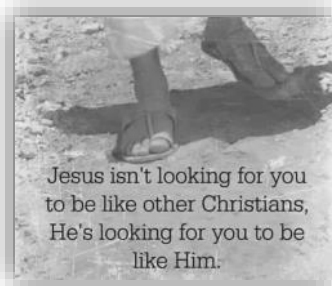
Congratulations
