





FREE FOR FREEDOM

Christ has set us free for freedom. Sound a bit strange? Consider Galatians 5:1. **“Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with the yoke of bondage.”**

The Galatians had been set free from the curse of the Law through Jesus. The danger was that they would fall back into the bondage of the law.

Paul’s appeal was for them to stand fast in their freedom. This can be difficult, because sometimes living in freedom is more difficult than living in bondage.

Living in bondage can be comfortable, because you don’t have to think. You just have to do what you are told to do.

I learned this by working in the prison system in West Virginia. Many of the inmates could function quite well inside the prison; but, could not function well on the outside. They were said to have been institutionalized.

Why? Because inside there were rules controlling almost everything, and violation of those rules brought immediate consequences. But, outside, they had to decide when to go to bed and when to get up, whether to go to work or not, who they should associate with, etc.—things they had no control over on the inside.

Christian friends, you have been set free. Stand in that liberty. Persevere in your freedom. Don’t return to the bondage of sin. Think! Make good decisions. Be responsible.

Sound difficult? It is, but this is the price of freedom.
