### **IT'S BEEN A GOOD DAY**

The late Johnny Mullins, an award winning songwriter from Springfield, MO wrote a wonderful song entitled “It’s Been a Good Day.” I have it on a CD by a trio called *High Strung*, all of which are members of the church.

The song is written from the perspective of a young woman who remembered her father’s simple prayers. That simplicity is reflected in the chorus, which says:

It’s been a good day, Lord, It’s been a good day.  
The children are healthy, they’re able to play;  
There’s food on the table, the cattle have hay;  
It’s been a good day, Lord, It’s been a good day.

This song reminds me of two important truths.

**First, as my father used to say, “Prayer is a simple open-hearted talk with God.”** There is no official prayer language, no God talk. I think we worry too much about the words we should say and forget to simply talk with God. He is our Heavenly Father, and He wants to hear from our hearts. So, keep it simple.

**Second, it doesn’t take extraordinary things to make out days good.** Like all of us, I have days that our unforgettable, days that transcend others. Yet, if I—and those I love—have health, food, shelter, friends, and the like, it’s been a good day.

I encourage all of us to count our many blessings, even the seemingly ordinary ones, and thank God is a simple, heart-felt way.

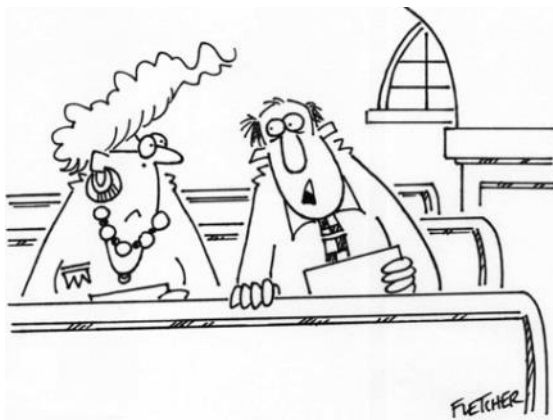
