MEMORIAL DAY

Memorial Day is a federal holiday observed on the first Monday in May to mourn and honor the men and women who have died while serving in the United States armed forces. Unfortunately, for many it has become only a day off from work and the opportunity for cookouts and picnics.

It is fitting and proper that we pause to remember the brave men and women who have given their last full measure of devotion for this country. It remains the land of the free, because of the brave.

It is also fitting and proper, and in keeping with Scripture (Acts 20:7), that we pause each Lord's Day to remember the sacrifice made by Jesus Christ on our behalf.

The Lord's Supper is a pictorial reminder of the fact that Jesus died for us at Calvary. The unleavened bread reminds us of His body, and the fruit of the vine reminds us of His blood.

In giving the Corinthian Christians information about this memorial, Paul wrote, "For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes (1 Cor. 11:26).

My brothers and sisters, let us not take the regular observance of this memorial feast lightly. Let us not willfully absent ourselves from observing it. To do so is to count His death as nothing.
