PROPER ATTITUDES OF A BIBLE STUDENT

For many years at the East Tennessee School of Preaching and Missions, I handed out the “Proper Attitudes of a Bible Student” to first-years students. I wanted to make sure that we started off on the right foot.

I ran across one of those sheets recently, and thought I would share it with you today.

1. The Bible is the inspired, inerrant Word of God and is all-sufficient for matters relating to the soul (2 Tim. 3:16-17).
2. The language of the Bible is purposeful and meaningful. Meaning can be extracted, and understanding can occur (John 8:32; Eph. 2:3-4).
3. A consideration of original languages may be essential to the correct understanding of a text (2 Tim. 2:15).
4. Truth is truth no matter where it is found or who says it. The same is true of error. We must be honest searchers after truth (Acts 17:11).
5. All truth should be accepted, regardless of tradition or commonly held beliefs (Matt. 15:8-9; John 17:17).
6. It is never wrong to question. All questions should be discussed openly, calmly and lovingly (Eph. 4:15; Col. 4:6).

Let’s all strive to be diligent students of God’s Word. The attitudes listed above will certainly help us do that.

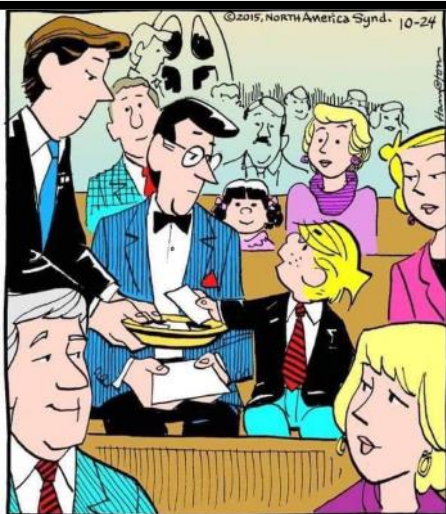
