FAMILY MATTERS

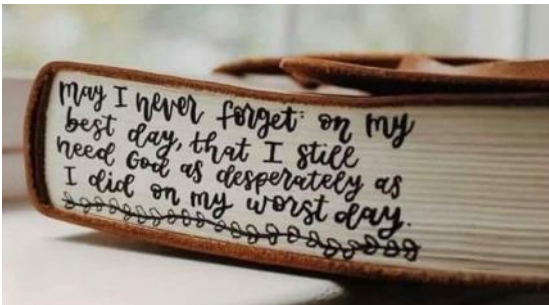
