





WORDS

“For we all stumble in many things. If anyone does not stumble in words, he is a perfect man, able also to bridle his whole body” (James 3:2).

Words are a precious commodity. James was so impressed by the power of words that he devoted the better portion of what we call chapter 3 of his epistle to the matter. In that chapter, he makes several crucial observations about what we say.

- We who would teach God’s Word to others must remember that we will be judged by the words we use (vs. 1)
- Misuse of words is so prevalent that those who don’t do so are as close to perfect (mature or fully grown) as humans can get (vs. 2).
- The tongue may seem small, but like a bit in a horse’s mouth, the rudder of a ship, or some small spark of flame, it can exert a great influence (vss. 3-6).
- We never get so careful with our words that we can’t drop our guard. The potential for evil and disaster is too great, and the tongue is too difficult to control, for us to become complacent or careless and speak unguardedly (vss. 7-8).
- It is inconsistent with one’s Christian faith to use the tongue as a vessel to bless God and then turn around and use it to adversely affect mankind who is in God’s likeness (vss. 9-12).

What we say makes a difference! It does so either in a good way or a bad way. As Christians, let’s be more committed to using our words for good rather than evil.


