If the person is a member of this congregation, they will be left on for as long as I feel necessary or prudent.

If you want a person included for a longer period, if the situation has changed, or if you want some specific announcement included in the bulletin, all you have to do is let me know. My purpose is to keep us informed, and sometimes I do a better job of that than other times.
