HOW QUICKLY PLANS CHANGE

We announced last Sunday that James Orrison, minister for the Mikes Branch congregation in Pikeville, KY would be with us today to talk about his work with the Skvyra Mission Team in central Ukraine. He is active in preaching, traveling, and raising support for this good work.

We are still interested in that work, but we have asked brother Orrison to reschedule his visit, due to the more urgent need in the Pigeon Forge/Gatlinburg area. As you know, that area was devastated this past week from wild fires fueled by extremely dry conditions and wind gusts that reached 87 miles per hour.

Our elders and deacons met last Tuesday to plan how we could be involved in any relief work in this area. First, it was decided that the entire contribution for today will be sent to the Gatlinburg church of Christ. This is not to rebuild their building. It was completely covered by insurance. This is so they might help the three families in the congregation who lost everything in the fires. With any money that is left over, they will help others.

Secondly, it was decided that we would seek to meet ongoing needs. For instance, **Melissa McBroom** and son, **JC**, took 7 boxes of coats to the Sevierville Rescue Squad last Thursday morning to be distributed to those who need them. Many escaped with only the clothes on their backs. Also, we are receiving the names of some of those in need, along with a specific list (sizes, etc.) of things needed. We will share these with your upon receipt of them.

This situation is very fluid, and we will seek to keep you informed regarding needs and how we may be involved.
