





William Barclay was a Scottish scholar who lived from 1917 till 1978. He could be classified as a heretic when it comes to the views he held on such things as the deity of Christ and the validity of His miracles. He was, however, an extremely talented writer and was often right on track with what he said, especially when it came to everyday life.

One of his better known statements is, **“Unless a man’s Christianity makes him kind it is not real.”** Amen!
