### **DAILY BIBLE READING SUGGESTIONS**

At the beginning of a new year, people often resolve to become daily Bible readers. If you have done that, or are thinking about doing it, consider the following suggestions.

- **Choose a good Bible with print that is large enough to see easily.** A self-pronouncing Bible will help. Also, choose a translation that you like and are comfortable with. I might recommend the English Standard Version. It is a good translation and easier to read than some others.
- **Set a time to read each day that is convenient for you, and do your best to honor that time.** Remember, it only takes about 15 minutes a day to read the entire Bible through in a year.
- **Begin and end each Bible reading session with prayer.** Make it a real period of devotion.
- **Read out loud.** It helps to hear the words as you read them. And, it will help keep you from becoming drowsy as you read.
- **Read with a highlighter or pen in your hand.** Underline key words and phrases. Make notes in the margin of your Bible. It will help things stick in your mind, and it will remind you to go back and dig a little deeper into the Word later.

I hope these down-to-earth, common sense suggestions will help.
