OUR TENTH ANNIVERSARY

The Seymour Church of Christ began in 2008 largely as a result of the interest and support of the Nashville Road Church of Christ in Nashville, TN. That good church, along with the Portland, TN congregation, wanted to see that congregations of the Lord's church were planted in every area of Tennessee where there is not one.

The rapid growth of the Seymour area, and the fact that some members of the church of Christ already lived in the vicinity, made it an ideal place to begin a new congregation.

The first service of the new congregation was held on January 20, 2008 with 37 people present. Those early services were conducted in the Seymour library and in the home of one of the members.

Tim Shoulders, former preacher for the Eastside church of Christ in Maryville, TN, became the first preacher for the congregation.

Arrangements were soon made to meet in one of the office buildings in Emert's Plaza on Chilhowie Road. Tim Shoulders continued his work with the Seymour church until July of 2013.

Upon his resignation to return to secular work, Tom and Sierra Miller returned to Tennessee, after four years in Ohio, to begin working with the congregation on September 1. They continue that work until the present..

In August of 2014, the congregation moved into the new, permanent facilities at 269 Business Park Lane.

It is altogether fitting that we mark and celebrate the 10th anniversary of the Seymour congregation. We are indebted to all those who have worked diligently to see that the congregation would flourish, and we give God the glory for all the progress made.
