

James Orrison, minister for the Mike's Branch church of Christ in Pikeville, KY, will be our speaker next Sunday morning for the Bible Study and Worship assemblies.

Brother Orrison began preaching while stationed in Gatesville, TX when he was in the United States Army. Upon his discharge from the army, be went home to Kentucky and began preaching on a rotating basis for six small churches in the area. He also began a radio program on WISI in Pikeville.

The Mike's Branch congregation asked him to come and help them in 1991, and he has been with this congregation since that time.

In 1999, James began his involvement with the Skvyra Mission Team. Skvyra is a town in central Ukraine, and he is actively involved in preaching, traveling and raising support for this outreach ministry.
