

THOUGHTS ABOUT EASTER

Today much of what we would refer to as Christendom is celebrating the resurrection of Jesus in one way or another. It is true that the New Testament gives no command or example regarding this matter. It is also true that we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord by assembling each Sunday, the day upon which He arose from the dead.

Therefore, we do not have an official church calendar with a special remembrance of the resurrection written in. This does not mean I believe it is wrong to talk about the resurrection of Jesus on the day most people are thinking about it. It is, after all, the single moST important event in all of human history.

I have been told that the late Gus Nichols stood before the congregation on Christmas and began with this question, "What is it that most people are thinking about today?" He answered, "The birth of Christ, of course." Then he concluded, "So, let's just talk about that this morning."

That's how I feel about today. In our series on salvation, I want to talk today about "The Foundation." Do you realize the foundation of salvation is the fact Jesus Christ died, was buried, and rose again on the third day? No resurrection, no salvation.

Paul put it this way in 1 Corinthians 15:17-19: "And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins! Then also those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men the most pitiable."

He arose! Hallelujah!
