





LEARNING FROM LOSS WORKSHOP

June 9-11

We have been talking about our upcoming “Learning from Loss” workshop for sometime now, and it is almost here. Let me use my page this week to give you some information about the workshop and the speaker.

Dean Miller is a long-time friend. He and I both preached in Stark, County Ohio, and our ministries overlapped some. He has been a preacher for more than 45 years. He is founder and director of the Widowhood Workshop Ministries, and spends his time traveling all over the United States conducting workshops about loss.

He lost his wife, Ruth Ann, to Parkinson’s on Christmas morning in 2013. This led him to research widows/widowers ministries and found that virtually nothing on the subject was available. He asked, “Why doesn’t someone do something about this?” And, so he did.

His workshops deal with the loss of a mate, but they also deal with other losses that people face. The complete list of dates, times, and topics is on the flyers in the foyer.

With the exception of the 10:30 a.m. session on Saturday, “Learning from the Loss of a Mate,” the sessions will be live-streamed. This session on the loss of a mate is just for those who have lost a mate through death or divorce. The sessions, except the Sunday morning worship session, will be informal. There will be plenty of time to ask questions, make comments, and share experiences.
