



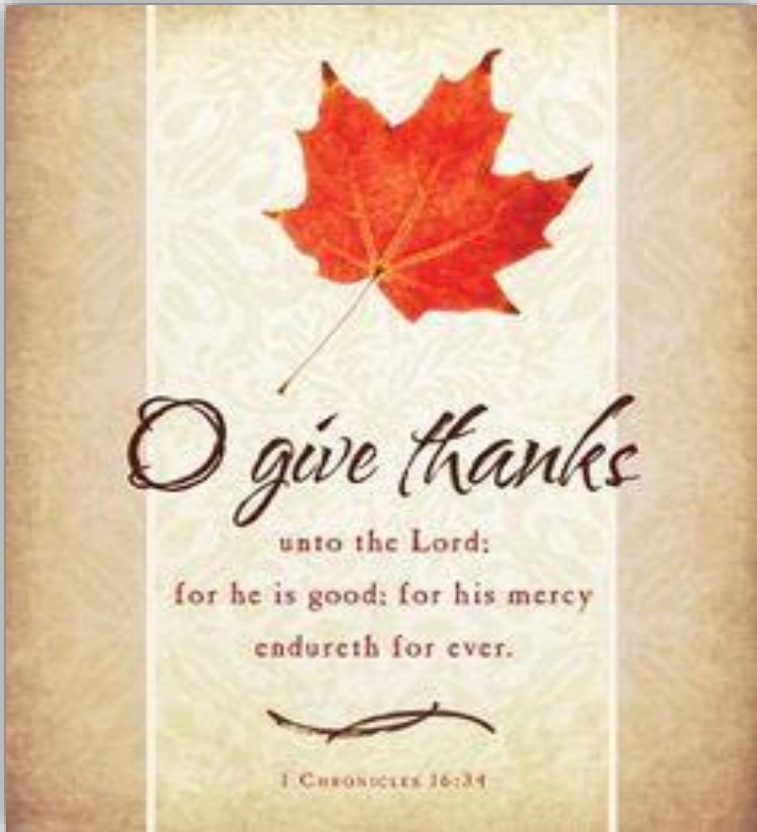

## **WHERE IS GOD ENTHRONED?**

Psalm 22:3 is an interesting, yet difficult, verse. Look at it in various translations.

“But Thou art holy, O Thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel” (KJV).

“But You are holy, enthroned in the praises of Israel” (NKJV).

“Yet you are enthroned as the Holy One; you are the praise of Israel” (NIV).

“Yet you are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel” (ESV).

Clearly there is a connection between God being enthroned and the praises of His people.

David began this psalm by asking why God had forsaken him. He said, “O my God, I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear; and in the night season, and am not silent” (Psa. 22:2).

David is asking, “Where are you God when I need You?” The answer is in verse 3. He is enthroned in/on the praises of His people. He is present in the worship of His people..

Eddie Clower wrote: “His people’s praises for His mighty acts in the past rise up to Him. They are like a huge cloud, a cloud that is received by God, who allows it to surround His throne as acceptable worship. It is as if His throne is lifted up by that cloud. ‘Surely, the Lord wants that same type of praise now,’ the psalmist implies” (*Truth for Today Commentary*, Psalm 1-50, p. 283).

This month, as we look at **Praise & Thanksgiving in the Psalms**, let’s remember that God inhabits the praises of His people and that He is present in our worship. Therefore, let us praise Him and give Him thanks!

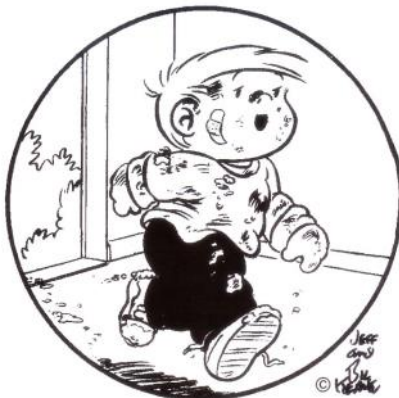
