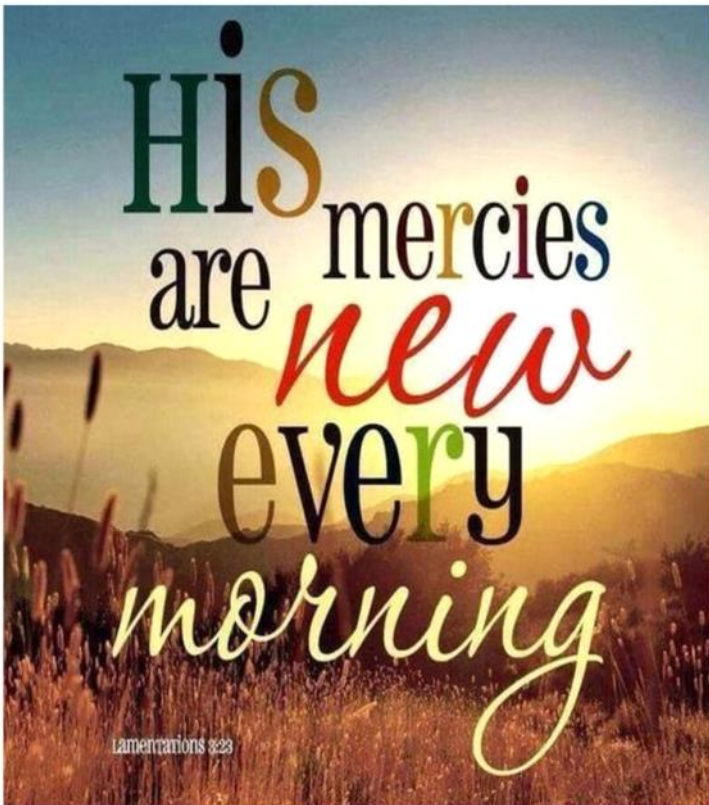

## **Please Help Us**

We work very hard to communicate with the congregation. A weekly bulletin is printed, which may be accessed online at [seymourcoc.org](http://seymourcoc.org) on Friday (*just click on the Publications tab*) or picked up on Sunday morning.

Slides are prepared which are run each Sunday before services and between the Bible study and morning worship. In addition, verbal announcements are made by one of our elders before each service.

In spite of this, people often comment that they did not know about a particular event or someone's illness. Here are some things you can do to help with this communication process.

- Be sure to read the bulletin on line or pick up a copy on Sunday.

- If you have an announcement for the bulletin, please write it out clearly and give it to me by Wednesday evening. The bulletin is prepared on Thursday morning and printed on Friday.
- If you have an announcement to be made publicly, please write it out clearly and give it to the elder in charge in a timely manner. Let's avoid announcements called out from the audience, if we can.
- If there is a very important emergency announcement, call Chris Bragwell or me, and we can send it out over our member's email list.
