COMMITMENT

Last Sunday morning, in the adult Bible class on the Gospel of Luke, we talked about some of the most often words spoken by Jesus as recorded in Scripture. They are:

“If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will save it. For what does it profit a man if he gains the whole world and loses or forfeits himself” (Luke 9:23-25)?

Jesus wanted His followers to know that there was no cut-rate price for discipleship. It involves some rather difficult things—things like denying self, bearing our cross daily, and following Jesus wherever He leads us. To those who heard Jesus speak these words, it might even mean death.

In the morning sermon, as I talked about “Understanding the Times,” I said we were going to call upon our members to be committed to the Lord, to do exactly what Jesus called upon His followers to do in Luke 9.

We often talk about “total commitment,” but there is no other kind. If commitment is not total, it is not true commitment. It is not a “um, yes and no” thing, as illustrated by the cartoon on the back page.

So, brothers and sisters, let’s renew our commitment to the Lord and this congregation. As is often said, “Let’s step up to the plate.” And let’s allow that commitment to be clearly seen in practical things like our regular attendance to the services of the church, our weekly contribution, our daily lives, and the way we reach out to those who are not Christians.
