RULES FOR HAPPINESS

Emanuel Kant was a German philosopher who lived from 1724 to 1804. He is a central figure in a study of modern philosophy.

One of the bits of wisdom from Kant that is often quoted is his Rules for Happiness. He said it involved (1) something to do, (2) someone to love, and (3) something to hope for.

I don't know exactly what Kant had in mind when he gave this list, but when I read it, I thought immediately of Christianity. I believe it provides all of those things for us.

It does give us something to do. Christianity is not just about feeling, knowing, or believing. It is about doing. After washing the disciples' feet as an example of service, Jesus said, "If you know these things, blessed (happy) are you if you do them" (John 13:17).

It also gives us someone to love, and that Someone is the God who created us and the Savior who died for us. Furthermore, it gives us fellow Christians to cherish. Christianity is a religion of love, and don't let anyone tell you otherwise. John wrote, "But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in Him. By this we know that we are in Him" (1 John 1:5).

And, who can doubt that it gives us something to hope for. We are not living a pipedream. Our hope is built upon the evidence presented in the Word of God. We hope for heaven, and that keeps us both anchored and looking forward. Hebrews 6:19 says, "Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast ..."


